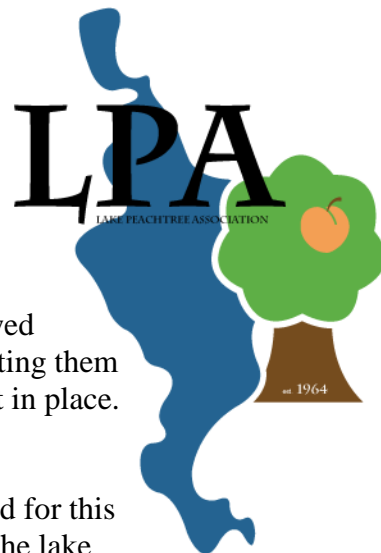


Neighbor Notes from the annual

Lake Peachtree Association meeting

The proposed PTC sewer installation project is now tabled. The City has followed through with a letter to all Hip Pocket area homeowners who have septic tanks, letting them know the process to follow in case their systems fail and another one cannot be put in place.

Police patrols on Lake Peachtree took place over four weekends but are now ended for this year. The police issued several warnings but no citations, for out of county use of the lake for fishing. We will reiterate that citations are called for in the future. Grass in the lake... is gone! The carp project, in which the County placed 1800+ new grass-eating carp into the lake, is considered a success. Hopefully in the future we will be able to stay 'ahead' of the grasses.

Lake Safety includes respect for the number of boats in the water; going around the lake in a counter clockwise rotation if there are more than three boats on the water; and especially watching out for all the swimmers. Triathlon trainers have been swimming in all parts of the lake, often alone, and usually with no accompanying boat or flag or any kind. **Let's be careful out there!**

Dragon Boat Races will be held September 26, 2009. Mark your calendars!
